All entrants will complete:

- 2 general questions about their past achievements (last 3-5 years)
- 1 general question about their future plans (next 3 years)
- 2 specific questions per category – please enter as many categories as appropriate to your agribusiness

All questions have a limit of 300 words maximum.

Further insight can be detailed in person during the on-site visits during the final stage of judging.

All entrants need to be located in Gippsland – within either Baw Baw, Bass Coast, South Gippsland, Latrobe, Wellington or East Gippsland Shire.

All information given in the entry process will be considered commercial-in-confidence and treated as such. The personal information provided will be used by Wellington Shire Council and Food & Fibre Gippsland for the purpose of Excellence in Agribusiness Awards. The personal information will be used for that primary purpose or directly related purposes and may be disclosed to other third parties if required to do so by law. The applicant may apply to Council for access and/or amendment of their personal information.

The judging team will seek your approval to speak with your referees to seek further information and verification in relation to your entry.

WINNERS
